The chosen candidate shall work as part of a five-member Project Management Unit (PMU) that shall work with the District Mineral Foundation (DMF) to monitor, plan for and implement development works in mining affected regions of Ranchi district. The Project Officer for Health shall focus on all works with special attention to health related works ongoing under the DMF.

Qualifications

The candidate must possess a graduate degree with a preference for those possessing a degree in rural development, management or social work. At least 2 years of work experience in the development sector. Preference given to candidates possessing experience working directly with the district administration.

Responsibilities

- Carry out diagnostic study to understand the socio-economic conditions in mining affected villages and analyse the impact (or deficit) of existing government schemes.
- Conduct Gram Sabhas and PRA exercises in all mining affected villages in the district in order to prepare list of projects to be taken up under the DMF and compile this into Annual Action Plans.
- Facilitate the approval of the Annual Action Plans in the Managing / Executive Committee and Governing Board of the District Mineral Foundation (DMF).
- Oversee the implementation of the approved projects, through regular field visits and raise flags at appropriate levels in case of potential delays or cost overruns.
- Promote community based monitoring tools like Social Audit of projects executed under the DMF
- Engage in non DMF work such as writing proposals and reports and making presentations.
- Report to the Team Leader, Planning and Monitoring Unit (PMU).
- Any other duties as may be assigned.
